the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said,

Julia D. Charles, her heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate:

"All that tract or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in the City of Greenville, beginning at a point on the south side of Hyde street, 173 feet from Westfield street, thence the northwest corner of the Davis lot and running thence along Hyde street N. 70° 34' W. 80 feet to the corner of Carpenter's lot, thence with line of last mentioned lot S. 69° 34' W. 150 feet to Gilfillan's line, thence with last mentioned line S. 70° 34' E. 80 feet to a stake, thence N. 19° 34' E. 150 feet to the beginning corner."
