on or about the 23rd day of March, in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and twenty-one, exhibited their complaint in the Court of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against Ansel Roy Davenport, et al.

demanding judgment in relation to the real estate, hereinafter mentioned and described; and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 18th, day of November, 1921, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate, hereinafter mentioned and described be sold by E. NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, E. Inman, Master in and for the County of Greenville, aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Nine thousand one hundred dollars, to me paid by the said John Davenport,

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said,

John Davenport and his heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate: "All that certain tract of land situate, lying and being in Grove Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, adjoining lands of John Moon, Wm. West and others and containing 164 and 71/100 acres, more or less, and being the same tract of land conveyed to Lizzie Davenport by John D. Harris by deed dated Feb. 3, 1903 and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. JJJ, page 399, and being the same tract of land owned by Lizzie Davenport at the time of her death, and having the following metes and bounds and courses and distances, as shown by plat of same made by Wm. N. Lee, Surveyor, Sept. 26-27-28, 1921 as follows:

Beginning at rock X3 in the Piedmont Road and running thence S. 77-3/4 E. 22.00 along said road, to an iron 3x at the intersection of the Piedmont Road and what is known as New Cut Road; thence N. 23-1/2 E. 5-1/2 to rock; thence N. 67-1/2 E. 4-1/2 to an iron pin X3; thence N. 44 E. 46.09 along the line of land of the T.M.
