

Contract of Sale and purchase.

State of South Carolina,  
 County of Greenville.  
 This agreement entered into this 1st day of October 1920,  
 between E. B. + P. O. Lewis + R. P. Thorne hereinafter called the  
 seller and J. P. Abercrombie hereinafter called the purchaser;  
 Witnesseth: That in consideration of the agreements and payments  
 hereinafter named, the seller agrees to sell and the Purchaser  
 agrees to buy, the hereinafter described lot of land at the price  
 of nine thousand one hundred twenty-five dollars. (\$9125.)  
 of which \$5.00 has been paid in cash and the balance  
 is payable as follows: Eight hundred + twenty-five  
 Dollars to be paid on or before October 5th. when bond  
 for title will be made to purchaser, balance of eighty  
 one hundred Dollars to be paid on or before January  
 2nd 1921 when a good and warranty deed for said  
 property will be made to purchaser. It is agreed  
 and understood that the purchaser will take over the  
 \$6000 Fire Insurance on this property which is written for  
 three years effective Oct. 1st. and that the purchaser will  
 pay one-fourth tax for 1920, until the purchase price is  
 paid in full, with interest on the unpaid portion from  
 date at the rate of 8% per cent. per annum to be  
 computed and paid on or before Jan. 2nd. and if  
 unpaid to bear interest at the same rate as principal  
 and in case said sum or any part thereof be collected  
 by an attorney or through legal proceedings of any  
 kind, the Purchaser agrees to pay ten per cent. in  
 addition to the amount as attorney's fee.

The seller agrees that there shall be made to the  
 Purchaser a good warranty deed for said property.  
 The property hereby agreed to be sold and bought as  
 follows: Dwelling situated on the west side of  
 Mills Ave. built by Lewis-Thorne Realty Co. and the  
 adjoining corner lot to same.

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This agreement made and entered into by and between  
 J. M. Albreton hereinafter referred to as the seller and Ella  
 Henderson hereinafter referred to as the purchaser. Witnesseth:  
 That the seller for the consideration hereinafter mentioned hereby  
 agrees to sell and convey to the purchaser all that certain  
 lot of land situated in the state and County aforesaid in the  
 Sixth ward of the city of Greenville, and having the following  
 meter and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin on  
 being lot #3 of the Albreton Lands according to  
 survey and plat of W. D. News, City Eng. and having a frontage  
 of 124 feet on Haynie St. and a depth of 114 feet along a  
 new street back to alley and being a part of a lot of land  
 conveyed to the seller by H. W. Spunt by deed bearing date  
 September 9th 1915 and recorded in R. M. S. office for Greenville  
 County in Vol. 36, at page 82, and the purchaser agrees to pay  
 therefor the sum of \$1250.00 Dollars, payable as follows:  
 50.00 in cash, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged \$15.00  
 Dollars per month, payable on the first day of each and every  
 consecutive month hereafter until the whole amount is paid  
 together with seven percent interest on same to be computed  
 and paid annually from date until the whole amount is  
 paid, that the purchaser complying fully with the terms  
 of this contract, the Seller agrees to execute and deliver  
 to her a good fee simple deed thereto free from all  
 encumbrances (over)
