And whereas, the said Clary Francis allows me to visit my said child, Floy Darby, at her home at any time. Now, know all men by these presents, that I the said Nellie Darby, for and in consideration of the premises, hereinafore stated and on further consideration of the confidence I repose in said Clary Francis, have agreed to and do hereby commit the care, custody, maintenance, education, and support of my said child, Floy Darby, of the age of three (3) months to the said Clary Francis.

Together with the rights, privileges and benefits, that could be exercised by me, as parent, over and in respect to my said child, Floy Darby.

To have and to hold, the said child, Floy Darby, to said Clary Francis during the minority of said child and until she is twenty-one (21) years of age, against me and any and all persons claiming or to claim any interest right or privilege through me in and to the said Floy Darby.
