Know all men by these presents that we John A. Smith and Louisa G. Smith (wives) of Greenville District and State aforesaid for and in consideration of four hundred dollars to us in hand paid by Edward Miller of Greenville District and State aforesaid have granted Bargained sold and Recorded and by these presents do grant Bargain sell and release unto the said Edward Miller all that tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in Greenville District and State aforesaid on Rocky Creek waters of Canons River being that tract of land laid off for me, the said Louisa G. Smith, and part of the original survey of Cha. Deaw and Moses Langley, containing one hundred acres, more or less. Beginning at a rock at Rocky Creek, thence S 80 W 16.60 to a stake corner, thence S 13 W 28.50 to a stake on R. Hamby's land; thence with Hamby's line S 33 E 30 chains to a rock corner, thence N 42 E a new line dividing it from E. Miller's land 50 chains to a poplar corner at the creek; thence up said creek 11 chains to the beginning corner, reference being had to a plat made by H. Wylly's September 1856 together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise appertaining.

To have and to hold, all and singular the said premises unto the said Edward Miller, his heirs and assigns forever. And we do hereby bind our selves, our heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular, the said premises unto the said Edward Miller, his heirs and assigns forever, against us and our heirs and assigns against every other person or persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
