

Whereas, Tully Hickson, Bolling Hickson, Mary Hickson, Walker and Nora Hickson Whitney, complainants, on or about April 15, 1919, filed their amended Bill of Complaint in the U.S. District Court for the Western District of South Carolina against J.A. Davenport et al, including as a defendant R.E.
