Abraham All that tract of land in Austin Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, about five miles east of Greenville Court House, near the Laurens Road and on Laurel Creek, containing 55.90 acres, more or less, according to survey made by P. G. Dalton Engineer November 27, 1911. Beginning at a white oak stump, corner of Matt Garrett property thence along said property N. 41-15-W. 33 feet to a white oak stump, thence the same direction N. 41-15-W. 33 feet to a stake on the bank of Laurel Creek, thence up the meanders of Laurel Creek to a point on a traverse line between said points being as follows: N. 2-0 W. 124 feet to a bend, N. 5-1-30 W. 147 feet to said point (a paper tree); thence continuing with Matt Garrett property N. 24-10 E. 420 feet to a stone corner of W.
