His heirs and assigns forever an undivided one-half interest of in and to all that piece, parcel and tract of land situate in said County of Greenville and State aforesaid about four and one-half miles from Greenville city, bounded by lands of Frank Foster and A. P. Farr on the north by J. A. Farr, lands on the east by A. P. Farr and S. C. Hawthorne lands on the south and by J. A. Foster lands on the west containing eighty-three acres, more or less, and being the land conveyed to me by D. P. Verna the 6th day of October 1887 and recorded in Book 11 at Page 395, and to him by A. P. Farr the 17th day of May 1887.
