All our right title and interest in and to the following tracts of land and fury and all other interest derived by us under the virtue of the wills of James M. Mc Gee and Matilda A. Mc Gee,

1. All that certain piece parcel or lot of land situated lying and being in the city of Greenville, County and state aforesaid and being more particularly described as follows: Beginning at the corner of Broad and Jackson Streets, 16 ft. 72 ft. 2 in to corner of Whitman's lot, thence N. 74 W. 200 feet with Whitman's line to a stake on River Street thence S. 16 ft. 72 ft. 2 in to a stake on Broad Street, thence S. 74 E. 200 ft with Broad Street to the beginning corner, being a portion of the lot of land conveyed to J. M. Mc Gee and C. Gray, July 2, 1886, deed recorded in Book R.R. page 136 R.M.C. Office of Greenville County.
