All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in the City of Greenville at the Southeast corner of Augusta Street and Dindal Avenue, having the following corner and bounds: Beginning at an iron pin the Southeast corner of Augusta Street and Dindal Avenue and running thence with Augusta Street S. 25-42 E. 91 feet to an iron pin the corner lot no. 3, thence with line of lot no. 3, N. 62-51 E. 189 feet to an iron pin on line of lot no. 43, thence N. 28-42 W. 46.4 feet to an iron pin on Dindal Avenue, thence S. 67-14 W. with Dindal Avenue 185.1 feet to the beginning corner being lot no. 2 as shown on plat of Cagle Park property, made by R.
