NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, E. Inman Master, in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree, and upon receipt of \$355.00 HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said

C. E. Shockley and his heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate:  
All those certain pieces, parcels or lots of land situated in Chick Springs Township, County of Greenville, and State of South Carolina land in the Town of Taylors and being known and designated as lots nos 11, 12 and 13 on a sub-division of Lot no. 4, property of W. M. Shockley, deceased, as shown by sub-division and plat of same made by Thos. P. Linder Nov. 10, 1921, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for the County and State aforesaid, in Plat Book "I" at page 20. Each of said lots has a frontage of 28 feet on the National Highway and runs back in parallel lines to the right-of-way of the Southern Railroad and the rear line of each lot is 28 feet.  
Reference is hereby made to the plat above referred to for a more particular description of said lots.

TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining; and all the estate, right, title, claim and interest whatsoever of the parties to the cause aforesaid, and of each of them in and to the same; and of all other persons rightfully claiming from, under, or any of them.
