I, E. Linnan
Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, Robert R. Moon

on or about the 1st day of November in the year of
our Lord nineteen hundred and twenty-one exhibited his complaint in the Court
of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against Miss Manie L. Moon, Frank Moon,
Maxwell Moon, Edward Olney Moon and Brown Moon,

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint: and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 25th
day of November 1921, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it
was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. Linnan
Master in and for the County aforesaid, to Robert R. Moon

for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear; (See Judgment Roll No.)
NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, E. Linnan
Master, in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree,
HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said.....

Robert R. Moon and his heirs and assigns forever, the following described real-estate:
"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situated in Grove Township, County of
Greenville and State of South Carolina, and containing 34 acres and being a part of a 170
acre tract of land belonging to the estate of John P. Moon, deceased, and having the
following metes and bounds and courses and distances as shown on plat of same made by
Wm. F. Lee, Surveyor on Oct. 8, 1921, to-wit:
Beginning at a rock X 30m, on road leading to Reedy Fork Church and running thence N. 15-1/4
E. 33.84 to rock X 30m by black jack; thence N. 76-1/4 W. 9.50 to rock X 30m; thence N. 69-3/4
W. 0.55 links to rock X 30m; thence S. 15-1/4 W. 33.84 to stake X 30m in road; thence S. 76
E. 10.08 to the beginning corner, and bounded by lands of Davenport, Monozite Lands,
Estate of John P. Moon and Cox Lands".
