Grover Jones, all the right, title and interest of Velma Cox in and to the following described tract of land to-wit:

"All that certain tract of land in Chick Springs Township, in the County and State aforesaid, containing 33 acres, more or less, and bounded by lands of Clifton Bryant, A. B. Bridwell, H. A. Taylor, and others, and being the tract of land of which Joseph Bryant, Decedent, died seized and possessed."

TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining; and all the estate, right, title, claim and interest whatsoever of the parties to the cause aforesaid, and of each of them in and to the same; and of all other persons rightfully claiming from, under, or any of them.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the premises before mentioned, unto the said Grover Jones, his heirs and assigns forever.
