H. W. Alessius and his heirs and assigns forever the following described real estate:
All those certain pieces or lots of land situated in Chick Spring Township, County of Greenville and State of South Carolina, and in the Town of Taylor and being known and designated as Lots Nos. 1 and 2 on a Subdivision of Lot No. 1 property of W. M. Shackley Deceased, as shown by Subdivision and Plat of survey made by Geo. J. Guelper, Nov. 10, 1921, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for the County and State aforesaid, in Plat Book 7 at Page 20. Lot No. 1 has as frontage on the south side of the National Highway of 33.1 feet and runs back a depth of 147.5 feet on side side and 142 feet on the other and has a depth in the rear of 13 feet and Lot No. 2 has a frontage of 28 feet on the south side of the National Highway and runs back in parallel lines 142 feet and 141 feet respectively, and has a depth in the rear of 28 feet.
Reference is hereby made to the plat above referred to for a more particular description of said lots
