Martin, all that tract of land situated in Greenville Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, about three miles from Greenville Court House, having the following courses and distances according to survey made by Fitzpatrick - Jerry to January, 1920: Beginning at an iron drain in the center of the road leading from the Eastley Bridge Road to the Piedmont Road and running thence S. 60° 42' E. 759 feet to point in the center of road; thence S. 71° 27' E. 457.4 feet to iron in center line of road; thence E. 27° 23' E. 543.3 feet to iron in center of road; thence leaving said road and passing at a distance of twenty feet over an iron S. 42° 30' E. 86.4 feet to iron in the drainage ditch; corner of property of H. St. Turner and in line of property of W. J. Trotter; thence along said Trotter's land S. 25° 38' E. 1808.9 feet to stone and iron on the side line of first above mentioned road and corner to property of Trotter and Cooper; thence N. 74° E. 21.78 feet to the beginning containing 20.82 acres, more or less, and excepting there from the right of way, one hundred feet in width deeded to and used by the Piedmont and Northern Railway Company, containing seventy-one hundredths of an acre, more or less, which exception applies to and extends across the eastern portion of the herein described property.
