F. Watson's line and running thence S. 54° 60' feet to stake; thence S. 83 1/2 E. 211 feet, more or less, to stake at corner of Prof. G. B. Moore's lot; thence north 60 feet along Moore's line to the Southeastern corner of Watson's line; thence along Watson's line 204 feet to the beginning corner, being the same conveyed to our deceased mother D.
