(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Melville C. Westervelt, as Trustee, All our right, title, and interest (each of us owning an undivided one sixth interest) of, in, and to all that certain tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in Greenville Township, County and State aforesaid, on the south side of the Augusta road, near the City of Greenville and having the following metes and bounds to wit: Beginning at an iron pin on the Augusta road; Davenport's corner and running thence with said road N. 54-45 W. 500 feet; thence still with said road N. 51 W. 200 feet; thence still with said road N. 49-50 W. 300 feet to an iron pin in the center of the intersection of a neighborhood road with Augusta road; thence with the center of said neighborhood road S. 20-30 W. 821 feet; thence still with center of said road S. 16-10 W. 363 feet; thence still with center of said road S. 32-15 W. 242.5 feet to an iron pin, corner of West property; thence S. 73-45 E. 966 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 21 E. 1345.5 feet to the point of beginning and containing 32.5 acres according to the survey of C.
