(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Allie W. Graham and her heirs and assigns, all that certain piece or parcel of land situated lying and being in the State of South Carolina, and County of Greenville, bounded and described as Lot number twelve (12) in Block #3 of Cagle Park, according to a plat thereof recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds, Greenville, and dated in Plat Book C, at page 258 and recorded, according to such plat the following way and bounds, to wit: Beginning at a tree now growing on the northwesterly corner of Mills Avenue on the corner of lot 11, and running thence along Mills Avenue S 87° 41' E twenty-six (26) feet to a slight bend in said avenue, thence still along Mills Avenue S 85° 28' E forty-one (41) feet to an iron post in corner of lot 11, thence along line of last mentioned lot N 2° 23' W one hundred and six (103.4) feet to an iron post in line of lot 11, thence along lines of lots more thirty-three and thirty-four S 89° 07' W.
