Lloyd her heirs and assigns, All that lot of land in Greenville Township, County and state aforesaid, in the south side of Dunbar Street having the following lines and bounds, to wit: Beginning at a stake on the south side of Dunbar Street, corner of lot no. 8, as shown on plat recorded in Plat Book C, page 163, and running thence with line of lot no. 6 in a southerly direction 215 feet to a stake, corner of lot no. 8, thence with line of lot no. 8 in a northwesterly direction 215 feet to stake on Dunbar Street, thence with Dunbar Street 215 feet to the beginning and being lot no. 7, grist above part, and one of the lots conveyed to me by J. E. Robison by the Deed dated March 3rd 1920 and recorded in Volume 68, Page 52, R. M. C. Office for Greenville County.

Also: All that other lot of land in the Township, County and state aforesaid, in the city of Greenville on the south side of Dunbar Street and having the following lines and bounds to wit:

Beginning at the iron pin at the west corner of lot now or formerly owned by Minnie D. Williamson on Dunbar Street and running thence along the south side of Dunbar Street 215 feet to an iron pin near of lot no. 8 on plat hereinafter referred to, thence S 18 W 215 feet to an iron pin, touching the A. C. Davis Land thence S 76 E 50 feet to an iron pin at the corner of lot conveyed by W. H. Justice to Minnie D. Williamson, thence N 18 E with first line of said lot 215 feet to the beginning corner known as lot no. 9 on plat made by W. A.
