(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

Ellison A. Smyth;
All that tract or lot of land in Greenville and Gant Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, about eighty acres thereof being in Greenville Township and about sixty-five acres thereof being in Gant Township, about three miles south of Greenville Court House, on the east side of the Columbia and Greenville Railroad, on both sides of the road leading from Greenville to Piedmont, and on both sides of Brushy Creek or Reedy River, having the following metes and bounds according to a survey thereof by J. L. Surrine May 9, 1918: Beginning at a point in center of Columbia and Greenville railroad track, corner of Duncan Mills property, and running thence with line of Duncan Mills S. 5° 54' - 15' E. 16 3/4 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 5° 9' - 15' E. 33 1/2 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 28° 30' W. 2400 feet to iron pin at spring; thence with the meanders of the branch to where it enters Brushy Creek; thence with Brushy Creek in a southeasterly direction to a black oak; thence S. 14° 40' W. 15 1/2 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 71° - 2' W. 95 1/2 feet to center of the Columbia and Greenville railroad track; thence with the center of said railroad track in a general northerly direction to the beginning corner.

The above tract is composed of two parcels, one of 115 acres conveyed to me by W. C. McRae May 17, 1918, and the other of 30 acres conveyed to me by Claude D. McRae on the same day.

It is understood and agreed that the mortgage executed by J. Adger Smyth Jr. to Claude D. Smith, dated May 17, 1918, recorded in R. M. C. office in Book 40, page 90, shall remain open for the protection of Ellison A. Smyth and his assigns from all liens or other encumbrances.
