All that certain piece of land and lot of land lying and being situate in the West side of Mallard Street between Garlington Street and Dunbar Street in Ward Five of the city of Greenville, County and State aforesaid and known as Lot No. 3 of a Plat of the Newell Property made by A. O. Jones March 31, st. 1913, said lot having the following

metes and bounds:  
Beginning at an iron pin in West line of Mallard Street 66 feet from corner of property owned by Silos Mcbee, this beginning corner being S. E. corner of lot No. 1 of said Plat; thence with the line of Mallard Street S. 21° 44' W. 66 feet to an iron pipe, this point being the N.
