TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned, unto the said S. C. Sentell, his  
heirs and assigns, forever.

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said  
S. C. Sentell, all that certain piece of parcel  
or lot of land situate, lying and being in the  
State of South Carolina aforesaid in Greenville Township,  
about two and one-half miles from Greenville  
Court House, and being known as lot No. 10 on plat  
made by W. A. Hudson Jan. 20<sup>th</sup> 1905, as shown  
by records in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County  
in Vol. "Nnn" at Page 426, and having the fol-  
lowing metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at  
corner of lot No. 9 on said plat, east side of  
Williams Street and running thence with line  
of lot No. 9 N. 59<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> E. 210 feet to a stake on Wright  
Street; thence N. 21-20 W. 70 feet to pin at corner  
of lot No. 11; thence with line of lot No. 11 S. 59<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>
