(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said B. H. Deason and Annie D. Smith their heirs and assigns forever X all that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, situated lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, about one and one-half miles east of Greenville Court House on the Spartanburg Road, and having the following meets and bounds to wit: Beginning at an iron pin on the north side of the Spartanburg Road, corner of Edwards land, thence along the north side of said road N. 69° 14' E. 50 feet to a point; thence N.W. about 400 feet, more or less, to a point on the rear line of this lot 400 feet distant from Edwards line, thence with rear line of this lot S. 13° 55' E. 41 1/2 feet to a pin on Edwards line, thence with Edwards line S. 13° 55' E. 42 1/2 feet to the beginning corner, and being the same lot of land conveyed to us by Geo. W. Merritt by deed dated September 29th, 1919 and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 49 at page 291. Also that other piece, parcel and lot of land, situated about one and one-half miles from Greenville Court House, on the Spartanburg Road and having the following meets and bounds to wit: Beginning at a point on the north side of the Spartanburg Road, fifty feet from the corner of Edwards property, thence along the north side of said road N. 69° 14' E.
