the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

W. H. McEver, All that certain lot of land, situate in the City of Greenville in the County and State aforesaid, known and designated as lot No. 31, of Block B<sup>1</sup> of Eagle Park, as shown on plat recorded in R.M.C. Office, lot Greenville County in Plat Book C page 238, and being more fully described as follows: Beginning at an iron pipe, on Indian Avenue corner of lot No. 30, and running thence S. 6° 53' E. 157.2 feet to an iron pipe; thence N. 87° 44' 27" 31.8 feet to an iron pipe; thence S. 89° 07' N. 30' feet to an iron pipe; thence N. 0° 53' N. 150' feet to an iron pipe, on Indian Avenue corner of lot No. 32; thence with Indian Avenue N. 84° 07' E. 61' feet to the beginning, being the same lot of land conveyed to and by William Goldsmith and W. D. Workman and Walter W. Goldsmith by deed dated August 20th 1919, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 54 page 146.

Subject however, to the following restrictions which are a part of the consideration for this deed, and are made for the benefit and protection of the other lots on the plat above referred to, which restrictions shall remain effective for a period of twenty years from the date of deed to William Goldsmith and W. D. Workman and Walter W. Goldsmith from Eagle Park Company, to-wit:

- (1) The property herein conveyed nor any part thereof shall not be sold, rented or otherwise disposed of to negroes.
- (2) The said property shall not be used for any unlawful business nor for anything which would constitute a nuisance.
- (3) The property herein conveyed shall not be recut nor subdivided so as to face any other direction than as shown on said plat.
- (4) No building shall be erected upon said property within twenty-five feet of the present line of the avenues above mentioned.
- (5) No building costing less than \$2500.00 shall be erected upon said lots other than out buildings appertaining to a dwelling.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining, TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned, unto the said W. H. McEver, his heirs and assigns, forever.

AND myself, my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said W. H. McEver, his
