J.W. Jones, All that lot of land situate, boun<sup>t</sup> and being  
in Ward Three on the South side of West Broad Street  
in the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid  
and having the following metes and bounds to wit:  
beginning at the corner of the said street 55 feet  
Eastward from the southeast corner of Broad and  
Jackson Streets, and running thence S. 17° 30' W. (parallel  
with Jackson St.) 100 feet to a stake in fence along  
the western side of said alley S. 72° 30' E. (parallel with Broad  
St.) 45 feet to a stake on said alley thence S. 17° 30' E.  
(parallel with Jackson St.) 100 feet to a stake on the  
south side of Street iron Street, thence S. 72° 30' W. along  
said street to the beginning, but feet however, for reservation  
as to the walls and the use thereof made contained in  
the deed to the above property to me by C.C. Huddman

2 mortgage in the sum of \$8,517.50 executed by  
J.P. Able to C.C. Huddman Nov. 8-1919 and recorded in  
Vol. 35 page 274, and payable as follows: \$1,458.75 payable  
on Jan. 1-1921; \$1,758.75 payable Jan. 1-1922 with interest  
at 6% per annum until maturity and then at 7%  
\$25.00 payable Jan. 1-1923; \$2500. Jan 1-1924 with interest at  
7% per annum.

3. Also a certain mortgage in the sum of  
\$2,500. executed by J.W. Kirkpatrick to A. G. Doherty  
March 25, 1920 bearing interest at 7%, payable annually
