the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have Grauged, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Lou Ida Cooper, All my undivided one-half interest in that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, near the City of Greenville, on the North side of the New Cut Spartanburg Road, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at a stake in the center of said Road, and the southeast corner of tract no. 2, and running thence along the line of tract no. 2 N. 7-31 E. 15-64-7 feet to a stake; thence N. 66-2 E. 397.5 feet to a stone; thence S. 52-36-2 E. 264 feet to a poplar; thence S. 14-44-2 E. 14.5 feet to a pine stump; thence S. 8-50 W. 229.5 feet to a poplar; thence S. 3-29 W. 65-6.5 feet to a stake in center of said New Cut Spartanburg Road, at the point of intersection with the old Spartanburg Road; thence with said New Cut Spartanburg Road S. 25-25 W. 483.3 feet to a stake in center of said road; thence still with said road S. 7-5-31 W. 181.8 feet to the beginning corner, and being known and designated as tracts nos. 3 and 4 on a plat of the property of L.
