KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS THAT J.C. Harper,

in the State aforesaid,
in consideration of the sum of
One Thousand Dollars and other valuable consideration DOLLARS

In hand paid
to and before me this day of Feb. 24, 1920 J.C. Harper

I, J.C. Harper, his heirs and assigns forever; All those two (2) certain lots of land situate
in the City of Greenville in the County and State aforesaid, known and designated as Lots
31 and 32 of Street 8, of Davis Park as shown on Plat recorded in the R.M.C. Office for
Greenville County in Plat Book 1, page 125, and being more particularly described as
follows:

Lot No. 31 - Beginning at an iron pipe on Tindal Avenue corner of lot 31 and running
thence S. 89-07 E. 61 feet to an iron pipe; thence S. 89-07 W. 61 feet to an iron pipe; thence
W. 89-07 E. 156 feet to an iron pipe on Tindal Avenue at corner of lot 32; thence with Tindal
Avenue, S. 89-07 E. 61 feet to the beginning corner, being the same lot of land
conveyed to me by William Goldsmith, W.D. Yorkman and Walter W. Goldsmith, by deed dated
August 20, 1919, and same deed being recorded in R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Vol.
54, page 125.

Lot No. 32 - Beginning at an iron pipe on Tindal Avenue corner of lot 32 and running thence
N. 89-07 E. 156 feet to an iron pipe; thence S. 89-07 W. 61 feet to an iron pipe; thence
W. 89-07 E. 156 feet to an iron pipe on Tindal Avenue at corner of lot 31; thence with Tindal
Avenue, S. 89-07 E. 61 feet to the beginning corner, being the same lot of land conveyed to
me by William Goldsmith, W.D. Yorkman and Walter W. Goldsmith by deed dated August 20, 1919
and same deed being recorded in R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 54, page 125.
Subject, however, to the following restrictions which are a part of the consideration for
this deed, and are made for the benefit and protection of the other lots shown on the plat
above referred to, which restrictions shall remain effective for a period of twenty years
from the date of deed to William Goldsmith, W.D. Yorkman and Walter W. Goldsmith from
Cape Fear Company, to-wit:

- (1) The property herein conveyed nor any part thereof shall not be sold, rented nor
otherwise disposed of to negroes.
 - (2) The said property shall not be used for any unlawful business nor for anything which
would constitute a nuisance.
 - (3) The property herein conveyed shall not be re-ent or subdivided so as to face any other
direction than as shown on said plat.
 - (4) No building shall be erected upon said property within twenty-five (25) feet of the
present line of the avenues above mentioned.
 - (5) No building costing less than Twenty-five hundred (\$2500) Dollars shall be erected
upon said lots other than out-buildings appurtenant to a dwelling.
- Subject, however, to the lien of two certain mortgages, one mortgage each over each of the
above described lots, executed by William Goldsmith, W.D. Yorkman and Walter W. Goldsmith
to secure the payment of the sum of Two thousand (\$2000) Dollars total, One thousand
(\$1000) Dollars being the mortgage debt on each lot, with interest at six per cent (6%)
from July 1, 1919, \$1000 mortgages dated July 1, 1919 and recorded in R.M.C. Office for
Greenville County in Vol. 62, page 156 ending, the same mortgages being assumed by
J.C. Harper in deed conveyed to him by William Goldsmith, W.D. Yorkman and Walter W.-
Goldsmith dated August 20, 1919. And as part of the consideration for this deed the said
estatee J.C. Harper does hereby expressly assume the said mortgages and mortgage debt,
together with interest from Feb. 25, 1920 until paid.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining,
TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned, unto the said,

J.C. Harper, his

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heirs and assigns, forever.

AND I do hereby bind
myself, my

heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said.
J.C. Harper, his

heirs and assigns, against me and
my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
