(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said J.L. Hawkins (an undivided two-thirds interest) and Mary Hawkins (an undivided one-third interest) and to their heirs and assigns, all that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina and County of Greenville, in Butler Township, about three and one-half miles from the City of Greenville, having the following metes and bounds, according to a plat thereof made by W.S. Baldwin, bearing date October 4, 1920, to-wit: Beginning at a stone on the south-east corner of a tract of 17.35 acres, conveyed by me to H.G. Burns (which tract fronts on the Scuffletown Road) and running thence S. 31 $\frac{1}{4}$ ° W. along line of the Burns land 10.90 chains to a stone on corner of land of Burns and Lawrence; thence along line of J.E. Lawrence land S. 35 $\frac{1}{4}$ ° E. 2.00 ch. to a large stone; thence along line of J.E. Lawrence land S. 20 $\frac{3}{4}$ ° W. 19.00 ch. to center of Charleston and Western Carolina Railway track; thence along the center of said track in a general southeasterly direction 6.55 ch.; thence N. 69 $\frac{3}{4}$ ° E. along line of land of S.L. McBee 23.60 ch. to an iron pin; thence N. 30° W. along line of C.C. Hindman land 9.68 chains to a post oak (down); thence N. 24 $\frac{3}{4}$ ° W. along line of lands of C.C. Hindman and T.R. Hunt 20.70 chains to the beginning corner. This is the south-east portion of the tract of land conveyed to me, the said J.E. Lawrence by C.C. Good by deed bearing date February third 1919 and recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds Conveyances for said County and State on the day of its date in Deed Book 34, at page 289. The tract of land hereinabove described and intended to be conveyed hereby contains forty-four and two-fifths (44-2/5) acres, more or less, according to the plat herein after referred to, but it is distinctly understood and agreed that the general warranty herein after contained shall not be construed as applying to any rights which Charleston and Western Carolina Railway Company may have in any land near their track, this deed being made subject thereto, and the grantee agreeing to purchase said tract of land subject to such right of way.
