Chapman as Executors of the Will of William T. Chapman by deed dated December 23, 1919, and recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County no. Vol. 60 page 15 and having the following metes and bounds, to wit according to survey made by W. L. Mitchell December 3, 1919. Beginning at a iron 3Xn in the road; thence N. 45 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 11.47 3X0, thence N. 23 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 7.86 to stake 3X0, thence N. 68 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 10.38 to stone 3X0; thence N. 57 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 8.52 to stone 3X0, bounded from the beginning by J. Ed.
