KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, R.E. Houston of the County of Greenville

in the State aforesaid,  
in consideration of the sum of  
One (\$10.00) DOLLARS,  
and other valuable considerations  
to me in hand paid  
at and before the sealing of these presents by Nannie L. Phillips

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

Nannie L. Phillips, All of my undivided one-half interest in and to:

(1) All those certain lots of land situate, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid in a Subdivision for W.H. Irvine, known as Perry Avenue Annex, as shown on a plat prepared by W.D. Neves in March 1912, recorded in R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book A., page 878, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin on the East side of Woodside Avenue 86 feet from the intersection of Woodside Avenue and Branwood Street and running thence S. 16-30 E. 86 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 73-30 E. 73 feet to an iron pin on an alley; thence along said Alley N. 10 W. 86-1/2 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 73-30 W. 82.3 feet to an iron pin, the beginning corner; and being known and designated as Lots Nos. 5, 6 and 7 on plat referred to above. These being the same lots of land conveyed to R.E. Houston and J.M. Phillips by H.P. McGee, et al., Trustees of W.H. Irvine, Bankrupt, on February 20, 1917, by deed recorded in Volume 40, page 273.

(2) Also, all those two pieces, parcels and lots of land situate in Greenville Township, State and County aforesaid, a short distance beyond the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, between the Woodside and Brandon Mills, and being known and designated as Lots Nos. 3 and 4 on a subdivision known as Perry Avenue Annex, surveyed and platted by W.D. Neves, March, 1912, which plat is recorded in R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book A., page 878. Each of said lots has a frontage of 28 feet on the east side of Woodside Avenue and runs back to an alley on the rear. These being the same lots of land conveyed to R.E. Houston and J.M. Phillips by E. Inman, Master, April 12, 1917, by deed recorded in Volume 14, page 485.

As part of the consideration for the above described lots of land the Grantee, Nannie L. Phillips, assumes and agrees to pay the following mortgages with interest thereon as therein provided from this date: (1) mortgage by R.E. Houston and J.M. Phillips to Piedmont Savings and Trust Company, dated March 5, 1917, for one thousand (\$1,000.00) Dollars recorded in Mortgage Book 56, page 102, which mortgage provides for seven (7) per cent. annual interest and covers Lots 5, 6 and 7 above described. (2) Mortgage by R.E. Houston and J.M. Phillips to Piedmont Savings and Trust Company for \$800.00, dated April 14th, 1917, recorded in Volume 63, page 18, providing for seven (7) per cent. semi-annual interest. This mortgage covers Lots 3 and 4 as described above.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned, unto the said Nannie L. Phillips,  
her heirs and assigns, forever.

AND I myself and my do hereby bind  
heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said Nannie L. Phillips, her

heirs and assigns, against myself and  
heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
