Workman, his heirs and assigns: All that piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, in the City of Greenville and having the following metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at an iron pin on South Main Street, at the Southeast corner of lot #2, of subdivision known as Markley Real Estate Company (plat of said sub-division being recorded in Plat Book C., page 145 R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S.C.), running thence N. 69.30 W. 110 feet to an iron pin on alley; thence with said alley S. 20.30 W. 30 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 69.30 E. 110 feet to a point on South Main Street; thence with said Street N. 20.30 E. 30 feet to point of beginning.
