Bridley, Trustees of the Neblett Free Library Association all its right, title and interest in and to all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land lying and situated in the Third Ward of the City of Greenville on the northeast corner of McBee Avenue and Westfield street, and having the following lines and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin on the corner of McBee Avenue and Westfield street and running thence in a northerly direction 175 feet more or less to Marsleys corner, thence along Marsleys line in an easterly direction 96 feet more or less to W.
