Coleman by deed dated Aug. 25th, 1915 and recorded in R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, Vol. 10, page 568, except twenty-two and one-half (22 1/2) acres, conveyed by me to C.H. Duck on Nov. 29th, 1916. This tract of land adjoins lands of J.T. McKinney, T.B. Bowen and C.H. Duck.
