In *Block Greenville situate lying and being on Bobo Alley and a no name alley and being more particularly described as follows:*

Beginning at the intersection of Bobo Alley and a new cut street, now known as Bynum street, and running through the middle of said Bynum street S. 60° 43' 274.3 feet to a stake in middle of said street; thence S. 27° 34' W. 137.9 feet to a stake; thence S. 56° 33' W. 51.3 feet to a fence post; thence N. 65° 29' W. 205.7 feet to a stake; thence N. 29.3° W. along side of unnamed Alley 149.7 feet to a stake on Bobo Alley; thence along south side of Bobo Alley N. 62° 26' 149 feet to the point of beginning.
