all that piece or lot of land in Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being all lots nos. 6-7 and 8 in the sub-division of the Pheron Earle property known as Oaklawn, as per plat made by R. J. Patrick Ferry Company, dated May 6th 1920, and recorded in Deed Book E page 274 in the office of R. M. C. of Greenville County, Greenville, the above mentioned sub-division being in Greenville Township of the Rutherford Road, near the city of Greenville South Carolina. It is also a part of the consideration for the property herein conveyed that no main dwelling shall ever be erected on any of the lots herein conveyed which shall cost in the aggregate less than the sum of Twenty-five hundred Dollars; that the front wall of any building erected on said lots shall not be closer to the line of any street than twenty feet; that none of the property herein conveyed shall ever be occupied by or conveyed to, or assigned to any negroes or associations of negroes or persons or persons of African birth or descent, and that all of said restrictions shall be binding upon the vendor, his heirs, successors or assigns.
