First: Beginning at an iron pipe on the east side of Bennett Street, 74 feet from the northeast corner of Bennett Street and Swiss Avenue; thence along the east side of Bennett Street N. 19-30 E. 75 feet to an iron pipe; thence along the south side of a 50 foot street S. 70-30 E. 150 feet to an iron pipe; thence along property of grantor S. 19-30 W. 75 feet to an iron pipe; thence along line of lot conveyed to John W. Lipscomb N. 70-30 W. 150 feet to the pipe on east side of Bennett Street at the beginning.

Second: Beginning at an iron pipe at the northwest corner of Bennett Street and Swiss Avenue; thence along the west side of Bennett Street N. 19-30 E. 71 feet to an iron pipe; thence at right angle to Bennett Street N. 70-30 W. 165 feet to an iron pipe on rear; thence along rear along property of grantor S. 19-30 W. 55 feet to an iron pipe on the North side of Swiss Avenue; thence along the north side of Swiss Avenue S. 66-0 E. 165.5 feet to the point of beginning.

Third: Beginning at an iron pipe on the west side of Bennett Street 71 feet from the northwest corner of Swiss Avenue and Bennett Street; thence along the west side of Bennett Street N. 19-30 E. 70 feet to an iron pipe; thence at right angle to Bennett Street N. 70-30 W. 165 feet to an iron pipe on rear line; thence along rear along property of grantor S. 19-30 W. 70 feet to an iron pipe; thence S. 70-30 E. 165 feet to the iron pipe at beginning.

Lipscomb, his heirs and assigns, that by accepting this deed, that no dwelling house shall be erected on any of said lots costing less than Five thousand (\$5,000.00) Dollars, and that the cost of said lots to said grantee have been reduced to him on account of the general benefit to the grantor's land or subdivisions of which said lots are a part, that said building restrictions as to cost of dwelling house shall have upon the value of other lots. Also it is agreed that no person of African descent shall hold the possession of said lots or occupy same.
