On the North side of S. Main street in the City of Greenville and being known and designated as Lot No. 24 of plat of the property of Thos. M. Walker Esq., record'd in the R. M. Co. Office for Greenville County, in Plat Book "E", page 146 and being more particularly described as follows: Beginning at a stake on the North side of S. Main street at corner of Lot No. 10 and running thence with line of Lot No. 10 and 30, N. 10-12 E. 143.4 feet to a stake on Chicora street, thence along line of Chicora street, N. 80-15 E. 25 feet to corner of Lot No. 23, thence along line of Lot No. 23 & 10-12 E. 144.46 feet to a stake on S. Main street; thence along line of said S. Main street in a westerly direction 36 feet to the beginning corner. This being the same lot of land conveyed to me by W. D. Westman, in the sum of One Thousand Forty-Severn and 85/100 (\$1,047.85) Dollars and record'd in said R. M. Co. Office, in Vol. 89, page 205.

Interest on the \$7,200.00 mortgage is assumed from Aug. 26th, 1920 and interest on the \$1,047.85 mortgage is assumed from Nov. 1st, 1920; and all taxes for the year 1920 are assumed.
