I, Emmal C. Neill

in the State aforesaid,
in consideration of the sum of
Twenty-Eight Hundred and Fifty (2850.00) DOLLARS,

to me in hand paid
at and before the sealing of these presents by

James T. Richey

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

James T. Richey

All that certain lot of land situated on the South side
of Tindal Avenue, County and state aforesaid, known and
designated as lot no 43, (Block 13 of Eagle Park) as shown
on plat recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in
Plat Book 1, C page 238 and having the following metes and
bounds: Beginning at an iron pipe on Tindal Avenue
corner of lot 2, being 185.1 feet from Augustal Street and
running thence with line of lots 2 and 3 S. 28° 42' E. 156.2
feet to iron pipe corner of lot 6; thence with line of lot
6 N. 73° 01' E. 60 feet to end iron pipe, corner of lot 42;
thence with line of lot 42 N. 26° 52' W. 160.6 feet to an iron
pipe on Tindal Avenue; thence with Tindal Avenue S. 68° 19'
W. 2.3 feet; thence still with Tindal Avenue S. 67° 14' W. 39
feet to the beginning corner.

Subject however to the following restrictions, which are
part of the consideration for this deed, and are made for
the benefit and protection of the other lots shown on the
plat referred to (which restrictions shall remain effective for a
period of twenty years from the date of September 20th 1919 see
to-wit:

1. The property herein conveyed over any part thereof shall
not be sold, rented or otherwise disposed of to negroes.
2. The said property shall not be used for any unlawful
business nor for anything which would constitute a nuisance.
3. Other property herein conveyed shall not be re-cut nor
subdivided so far to face any other direction than as shown
on said plat.

4. No building shall be erected upon said property within
twenty-five feet of the present line of Tindal Avenue.
5. No building costing less than twenty-five hundred dollars
shall be erected upon said lot other than out buildings
appurtenant to a dwelling.

It is understood and agreed that as a part of the con-
sideration hereinabove expressed that the grantee, James T. Richey is to assume and pay for certain rates and
mortgage covering the above described premises, in the
sum of Eleven Thousand and fifty (\$11,50.00) Dollars,
executed by Emmal C. Neill on May 31st 1919, due
May 31st 1930 and recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville
County in Vol. 62, page 150 together with interest thereon
from date until paid.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.
TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned, unto the said

James T. Richey, his
heirs and assigns, forever.
