Godfrey Webster All that certain piece parcel or lot of land in the County and State aforesaid, near the City of Greenville, in the sub-division known as "Hannibal" and situated on the north side of Oregon Street and known as lot #6 of Block "C" one part of the said property recorded in R. M. C. Office for said County in Plat Book "E" at page 66-67. The said lot has the following metes and bounds: beginning at a stake on the north side of said Oregon Street at corner of lot #5 said to Wm. St. Hanchel and running thence along said street N. 63° 30' E. sixty feet to stake at corner of lot #7; thence along said lot N. 26° 30' W. one hundred and sixty-five feet to stake on line of lot #15; thence along said lot S. 63° 30' W. 60 feet to stake at corner of lot #5; thence along said lot S. 26° 30' E.
