to it in hand fully paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee hereinabove named (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto

the said corporation lot or parcel of land situated lying and being on the northeast corner of Wooddale Avenue and Byrd Boulevard in the subdivision known as Trapp's Park in Greenville Township, County and State aforesaid and being better known and designated as lot No 200 of Trapp's Park, as shown on a plat made by R. G. Miller, 5th March 1915, and bearing, according to said plat, the following lines and corners, to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin the northeast corner of Byrd Boulevard and Wooddale Avenue and running thence with Byrd Boulevard S. 66° 33' E. 50 ft. to an iron pin one line of lot No 200, thence with the line of that lot N 29° 33' E. 127 ft. to an iron pin on line of lot No 205, thence with the line of that lot N 57° 40' W. 48 feet to Wooddale Avenue, thence along the S. side of Wooddale Avenue 507 5 ft. to the point of beginning.

Upon the following restrictions and conditions, to-wit: (1) The property shall never be sold, rented or otherwise disposed of to negroes or persons having any percentage of negro blood. (2) no liquor or spirit shall ever be sold on said premises. (3) The property shall be used exclusively for residential purposes. (4) No house shall be built nearer to Byrd Boulevard than 6 ft. nor shall any dwelling house be erected on said premises costing less than \$1,500.00. (5) No use shall be made of this lot or any part thereof which would constitute a nuisance or injure the value of any of the neighboring lots. (6) The grantor specifically reserves the right to lay and place upon authorizing the laying and placing of street car or electric railway tracks, cable and water pipes and to erect or authorize the erection of electric telegraph or telephone poles or the installation of any other work or utility on or along any of the roadways adjacent to said property without liability for any consequential whatsoever to the grantee, his heirs or assigns.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the premises before mentioned unto the grantee hereinabove named, and his

heirs and assigns forever.

And the said granting corporation does hereby bind itself and its successors to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee hereinabove named, and his

heirs and assigns, against itself and its successors, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
