Exchange Permit.

Received of the Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company One Dollar in consideration of which I hereby grant, unto said Company, its successors and assigns, the right, privilege and authority to construct, operate and maintain its lines of telephone and telegraph, including the necessary aerial cable, poles, wires and fixtures, upon and over the property which I own, or in which I have an interest 310 Crescent Ave., in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville and State of S.C., said sum is received in full payment of said rights.

The Company agrees to re-locate on said property, its line and fixtures to conform with future building improvements. This right permits line & fixtures on rear property line only as agreed upon and to extend underground pipe from pole to existing pipe box in residence.
