Whereas, S.S. Gregory is the legal owner of a pipe line or water main, tapping the City main near the Trio Grocery and running thence up Douglas Street to Lee Street, thence along Lee Street to Monroe Street, aggregating a total distance of approximately 2000 feet, and

Whereas, A.G. New owns some lots adjacent to said water main and is desirous of tapping on or connecting with said water main at the intersection of Douglas Street and Lee Street for the purpose of furnishing water to his lots:

Now Therefore Know all men by these presents, That this agreement made and entered into by and between S.S. Gregory, party of the first part and A.G. New, party of the second part this 25th, day of June 1922, Witnesseth:

That S.S. Gregory for end in consideration of the sum of Seventy-five (\$75.00) Dollars, to me in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged by A.G. New, does hereby grant, bargain, sell and deliver unto A.G. New, his heirs and assigns the right and privilege to make one One (1) inch tap or connection upon the water main as aforesaid, subject to the following terms and conditions:

- 1. That the said tap or connection shall be made at the intersection of Douglas Street and Lee Street and shall be a one inch pipe.
- 2. That S.S. Gregory shall not sell such connections from his main in the future as will materially interfere with the flow of water in the one inch connection herein granted to A.G. New. Witnesses:
