Jones, Lucy Gildin, Lizzie Bates, their assiciates and successors, members of the "Mateon Presbyterian Church are hereby constituted and declared a body politic and corporate, under the name and style of the "Mateon Presbyterian Church, of Greenville County.

Said corporation shall have power to purchase and held real estate or personal property, not exceeding in value the sum of Fifty thousand Dollars; and to sell and convoy or dispose of the same in any manner whatsoever; and, by its corporate name, to sue and be sued in any of the Courts of the State, and to make such rules and by-laws, not repugnant to the laws of the land, as may be deemed necessary, to make, use and keep a common seal, and the same at will to alter.

In Witness whereof, I have hereunto set my hand and affixed the Seal of the Court at Greenville, this seventeenth day of August, in the year of Our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty-five, and in the 110th year of the Independence of the United States of America.
