Ables do hereby declare that we did not intend the legal effect a condition subsequent has upon the title to the property, and it was not our intention to work a forfeiture or create a reversion on any interest, or to fix a conditional limitation of, in and upon said title or titles upon a violation of any of said conditions, and in consideration of the foregoing premises and of the sum of Five Dollars, to us in hand paid, we, and each of us, do hereby waive, renounce, release and quit-claim unto all persons and Corporations, who have heretofore or may hereafter take title to said property to them, their heirs, successors and assigns, any and all right or forfeiture of title, or right of reversion of any and to said land.

And we do hereby bind ourselves, our heirs, executors and administrators not to claim any forfaiture of title or reversionary interest of in, or to said lands, or any part thereof.

The lands referred to are fully described in deeds recorded in Vol. 43, at page 537 and Vol. 25 page 442 respectively, to which reference is made as a part of the description hereof.
