

Sundays and legal holidays excepted, for the rights and property demised, but in case party of the second part for any cause does not actually quarry and ship 330 tons on any one day, then any payment made for that day, over and above the number of tons actually quarried and shipped, shall be applied to the payment of any rock or stone thereafter quarried and shipped in excess of 330 tons per day.

It is further agreed that if during any one year during the continuance of this lease any payments for royalty which may have been paid prior to January 1st of any successive year over and above the products shipped to that date shall not be applied on the royalty of 5 cents per ton provided herein on the tonnage over the amount of 330 tons per day actually quarried and shipped after said January 1st, but the amount paid in each year shall be applied solely to the amounts due in that year and shall not be extended over to any successive year.

Fourth: That the party of the second part shall have the right and option to purchase said lands, machinery, railroad, quarry and railroad equipment and other property covered by said lease, and this supplemental contract, at any time within one year from January 1st, 1923, for the sum of One hundred thousand (\$100,000.00) net.

This supplemental contract shall inure to the benefit of and be binding upon the heirs, executors, administrators and assigns of the parties hereto.

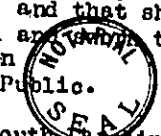

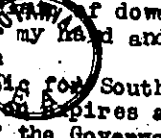
