Provided the said Franklin Guy Henderson and James Clarence Henderson for services herein provided for shall have the use of the shop and be entitled to all profits therefrom, and to use said premises as a home for themselves and family.

Now, Known all men by these presents, that we, the said Laura Henderson, Lula Henderson, Leila Henderson Ridgeway, Lillie Mae Henderson, Carrie Bell Henderson, Franklin Guy Henderson, and James Clarence Henderson, as heirs at law of the said J. M. Henderson, deceased, do hereby agree that the aforesaid premises shall be kept together for the purpose of providing a home and support for the said Laura Henderson, Lula Henderson, Lillie Mae Henderson and Carrie Bell Henderson, so long as they, or either of them, shall live and remain single and desire to reside at the home place, and

It is further agreed, that on the death or marriage of the said Laura Henderson, Lula Henderson, Lillie Mae Henderson, and Carrie Bell Henderson, or in the event all of them should take up their abode somewhere else that this contract shall become null and void and the property shall be divided for the benefit of the undersigned, their heirs and assigns, just the same as if this contract had not been entered into.
