

Whereas on Dec. 9, 1898, H.S. Nabors and others conveyed a tract of land unto Joe Nabors for the term of his natural life and at his death to his children by his second wife, by deed recorded in R.M.C. Office for Greenville Co. in Book DDD, page 462, and now the said Joe Nabors having departed this life and it being desired by his children to divide the lands in kind, there being three of said children, to-wit: Frankie C. Nabors Bayne, Carrie B. Nabors Bayne and Blythe Nabors, the two first mentioned being the two referred to in the deed above named and the last mentioned being a child born after the execution of the said deed, this deed is now made for the purpose of said division:

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of..... One Dollar and the premises

to..... us..... in hand paid at and, before the sealing of these presents by.....
Blythe Nabors

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold, and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Blythe Nabors: "All our right, title and interest which is a two-thirds undivided interest, each owning, a one-third undivided interest in and to the following described tract of land, which said land is a portion of the 103 1/2 acres covered by a deed which is recorded in the Office of R.M.C. for Greenville County in Book DDD, at page 462, said tract being specifically described as follows:
Beginning at a stone on Fork Shoals Road and running thence N. 75 E. 40.70 chains to stone on A.G. Huff's line; thence N. 16.50 W. 11.22 to stone, corner of lots #2 & 3; thence with line of lot #2, S. 69 W. 35.85 to stone; thence S. 80 W. 6.25 to stone on Fork Shoal Road; thence down said road S. 12.75 E. 8.22 to the beginning corner, and containing Thirty-seven and 28/100 (37.28) acres, more or less, according to survey made by W.J. Riddle in Feb. 1924, and known as Lot #1 on a plat made by him of said survey."

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TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.
