Harris' on the Easley Road and the Southern Railway containing Two hundred and Eleven (211) acres, more or less, known as the Parrish Place, bounded by lands of N.H. Harris, H.K. Townes, Dave Burns and Odd Fellows Orphanage and others; and being Tracts Nos. 1 to 8, both inclusive, of the lands of the Estate of R.G. Williams, deceased, as shown by Plat of same originally made by H.Olin Jones, Architect and Engineer, on July 21, 1913 and subdivided by R.E.
