C. Garrett's line and at corner of tract owned by myself and running thence N.E. 16° 35' 72 to a stone 3 $\frac{1}{2}$  on Mrs. M. J. Gray's line; thence N. 16 $\frac{1}{2}$  E. 7.16 to a stone 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ ; thence N. 82 1/2 W. 44 to stone 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ ; thence with Garrett's line about 44.00 to the beginning corner, the same being a part of the tract of land conveyed to my mother, E.
