the following, westerly and northerly to-wit,  
beginning at an iron post on the North West side of the Spartanburg Road, (said post being the East corner of lot No. 11-3) and running N. 58-25 W. 255.3 feet to the iron post, thence N. 58-37 E. 182.6 feet to an iron post whence S. 48-56 E. 218.4 feet to an iron post on Spartanburg Road; thence S. 41-04 W. 78.5 feet to an iron post, the point of beginning, according to a plat of the Overbrook Land Company, by H.
